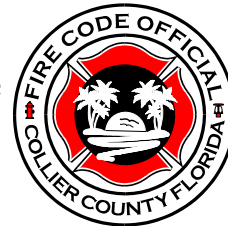

ARTICLE NUMBER: COD 10-1

EFFECTIVE DATE: 4/7/2010

SUBJECT: Signage to Identify Buildings with Light Frame Truss Construction

OBJECTIVE: Provide consistency throughout Collier County; giving direction on the placement of additional signs.

BACKGROUND: F. A. C. 69A-60.008 (7)-(9) gives the AHJ the authority to require additional signs

POLICY/PROCEDURE: There shall be one sign as described in 69A-60.008 at the “Main entrance” to comply with the law. The AHJ may require an additional sign to be placed at the posted address (or building identifier) which is required to be visible from the street. If there is not a definable “main entrance” then there shall be a sign at each end of the building visible to the emergency responders as they arrive.

You may choose a vendor of your choice as long as the sign meets the requirements in 69A-60.008. Below is a short list of known vendors.
