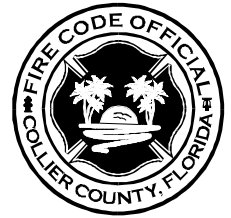


Collier County Fire Prevention and Protection Code POLICY AND PROCEDURE MANUAL

EFFECTIVE DATE: March 01, 2004

SUBJECT: Fire Suppression Systems for Concession Stands

OBJECTIVE: To set a policy for Collier County in regards to the protection of cooking operations in permanent or temporary concession stands.

BACKGROUND:

The Fire Districts have agreed to one county wide policy in regards to the protection of cooking operations that involve the use of deep fat frying that can produce grease laden vapors in concession stands, whether permanent or temporary.

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

The Fire Districts of Collier County require that all temporary or permanent concession stands be equipped with a UL 300 hood and suppression system or equivalent device or system. The local AHJ may, on a case by case basis, wave this requirement when an alternative arrangement is approved by the local AHJ.
